S. aureus bacteraemia surveillance Quarterly report

April – June 2013 (Q2 2013)

Key points

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) rates for Northern Ireland (NIFA plus NIFA bacteraemia) decreased by approximately 4% during quarter 2013.
- NIFA rates decreased by approximately 20% compared to quarter one 2013 (from 22 to 18 reports).
- NIFA reports during 2013-14 fell 27% compared to 2011-12.
- NIFA rates increased by approximately 4% compared to quarter one 2013 (from 18 to 19 reports).
- NIFA reports during 2013-14 fell 4% compared to 2011-12.
- SA rates for quarter one 2013 remain within expected parameters on the SPC chart for Northern Ireland.
