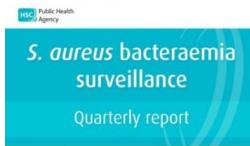

October 2015 - December 2015

Key points

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) rates for Northern Ireland (NI) and NIH (Northern Ireland) decreased by approximately 25% during October-December 2015 compared to July-September 2015.
- NIH SA rates decreased by approximately 51%, during October-December 2015 compared to July-September 2015.
- NIH SA rates during 2014-15 rose by 6% compared to 2013-14.
- NIH SA rates decreased by approximately 19% compared to July-September 2015.
- NIH SA rates during 2014-15 decreased by 17% compared to 2013-14.
- NIH SA rates remain within expected parameters on the SPI2 chart for Northern Ireland.
