July 2016 – September 2016

**Key points**

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) cases for Northern Ireland (NI) and HSCA (HSC Agency) increased by approximately 7% during July-September 2016 compared to April-June 2016.
- HSCA cases increased by approximately 20% during July-September 2016 compared to April-June 2016.
- HSCA cases during 2016/17 met by 12% compared to 2014/15.
- HSCA cases increased by approximately 4% compared to April-June 2016.
- HSCA cases during 2016/17 increased by 14% compared to 2014/15.
