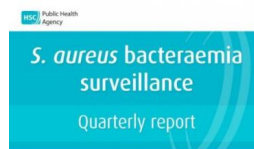

October 2016 – December 2016

Key points

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) rates for Northern Ireland (NI)SA plus MSSA (methicillin-resistant) increased by approximately 5.4% during October-December 2016 compared to July-September 2016.
- MSSA rates increased by approximately 12% during October-December 2016 compared to July-September 2016.
- MSSA reports during 2016-16 rose by 12% compared to 2016-15.
- MSSA rates remained at approximately 5% compared to July-September 2016.
- MSSA reports during 2016-16 increased by 14% compared to 2016-15.
