October 2016 – December 2016

**Key points**

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) rates for Northern Ireland (NIFA) plus WGS (whole genome sequencing) increased by approximately 5.4% during October-December 2016 compared to July-September 2016.
- WGS rates increased by approximately 17% during October-December 2016 compared to July-September 2016.
- WGS reports during 2016-16 used by 17% compared to 2016-15.
- WGS rates increased by approximately 3% compared to July-September 2016.
- WGS reports during 2016-16 increased by 14% compared to 2016-15.
