**Key points**

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) rates for Northern Ireland (NIFA) and WISCA (ambulatory) increased by approximately 7% during July - September 2017 compared to April - June 2017.
- WISCA rates increased by approximately 40% during July - September 2017 compared to April - June 2017.
- WISCA reports during 2016/17 fell by 20% compared to 2015/16.
- WISCA rates increased by approximately 7% during July - September 2017 compared to April - June 2017.
- WISCA reports during 2016/17 increased by 10% compared to 2015/16.
