Key points

- Overall S. aureus (SA) rates for Northern Ireland (NI) SA and MSSA (methicillin-resistant) increased by approximately 7% during July - September 2017 compared to April - June 2017.
- MSSA rates increased by approximately 40% during July - September 2017 compared to April - June 2017.
- MSSA reports during 2016/17 fell by 20% compared to 2015/16.
- MSSA rates increased by approximately 7% during July - September 2017 compared to April - June 2017.
- MSSA reports during 2016/17 increased by 10% compared to 2015/16.
