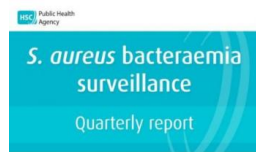

October - December 2017

Key points

- Overall 2. seven (24) cases for Northern Ireland (NI) (S. aureus bacteraemia) increased by approximately 9% during October - December 2017 compared to July - September 2017.
- MRSA cases decreased by approximately 9% during October - December 2017 compared to July - September 2017.
- MRSA reports during 2016/17 fell by 20% compared to 2015/16.
- MSSA cases increased by approximately 9% during October - December 2017 compared to July - September 2017.
- MSSA reports during 2016/17 increased by 19% compared to 2015/16.
