Flu vaccine information for health professionals

Patient category	Vaccine given
At-risk children under two years old 	Seqirus Quadrivalent Inactivated cell-based Influenza Vaccine (QIVc); Flucelvax Tetra 
Pre-school children from two years old 	AstraZeneca Trivalent Live Attenuated Influenza Vaccine (LAIV); Fluenz* 
All primary and secondary school children up to and including Year 12 	AstraZeneca Trivalent Live Attenuated Influenza Vaccine (LAIV); Fluenz* 
At-risk young people aged 16 and 17 years old 	AstraZeneca Trivalent Live Attenuated Influenza Vaccine (LAIV); Fluenz* 
At-risk and eligible adults under 65 years old (including healthcare workers and pregnant women) 	Seqirus Quadrivalent Inactivated cell-based Influenza Vaccine (QIVc); Flucelvax Tetra 
Adults 65 years and older 	Seqirus Adjuvanted Quadrivalent Inactivated egg-based Influenza Vaccine (aQIV); Fluvad Tetra** 

*If medically contraindicated, individual should receive Seqirus QIVc. Contains gelatine from pork.

**If contraindicated because of egg allergy, individual may receive Seqirus QIVc.
