#### Introduction

This resource is intended to help primary care professionals to assess and address the health needs of patients from Ukraine.

Soon after individuals and their families arrive in Northern Ireland from Ukraine, they should be supported to register with a GP practice and attend a New Patient Health Check.

There may, however, be several interactions with the Health and Social Care (HSC) system linclucing in primary care) before GP registration takes place and all primary care professionals have a role to help support access to HSC services.
