The Early Intervention Support Service (EISS) operates in five areas across Northern Ireland. The service aims to support families when problems arise, before they need involvement with statutory services.

The EISS delivers and coordinates person-centred, evidence-based, early intervention for families with children 0-18 years within Tier 2 of the Hardiker Model.
