



The PHA is reminding pregnant women to get the whooping cough (per vaccine between 16 and 32 weeks of their pregnancy. The majority of children who are reported as having whooping cough are infants under months of age so are too young to be protected by their routine childhoo immunisations which are given at two, three, and four months of age. 
